## TimeOnline2 We are pleased to let you know that you will be able to use TimeOnline2(TOL2) from the beginning of May.

**What is it?** TOL2 is the new software from Timebanking UK which allows you/us to enter requests and mark exchanges as pending and then completed when they have been undertaken, etc.

**How will I access it?** You will be able to have a look at the new pages at https://tol2.timebanking.org/southampton

**Can I get it on my mobile?** If you have an android phone you will be able to download the app from the google store. TBUK and their developers are still working on the app for I-phone.

Further information will be included in the May newsletter and we will also send the Members Guide for those who receive the newsletter electronically. You can also talk to Gwyneth or Lynda and ask them for a demonstration or help if needed.
