Apply to Save on Energy Bills

It's early days, but a number of energy suppliers are already open to applications for the 2019-20 Warm Home Discount.

The <u>Warm Home Discount</u> is a scheme providing eligible households with a £140 electricity bill discount for winter. This discount is available to credit and pre-payment customers, providing the supplier is part of the scheme and the customer meets eligibility criteria. It's worth applying early, as the discounts are offered on a first-come, first-served basis.

So far, the scheme is open to customers of the following suppliers:

EDF Energy; nPower, Sainsbury's Energy, Scottish Power, Utility Warehouse

More suppliers will be open to the scheme in the coming months, so keep your eyes open if your supplier doesn't appear in the above list.
